EXPERIENCIA CENTRO HISTORICO/ DOWNTOWN EXPERIENCE




XOCHIMILCO + COYOACÁN +FRIDA KAHLO


BALLOON RIDE + PYRAMIDS

PUEBLA AND CHOLULA








TAXCO & CUERNAVACA

CONTEMPORARY ART AT SAN MIGUEL CHAPULTEPEC

TOWERS OF SATELITE + CUADRA SAN CRISTÓBAL

Description: Travel north of the city & introduce yourself to some of the architect's most iconic works: The Towers of Satélite (Torres de Satélite), Cuadra San Cristóbal (the stables), the Fountain of the Lovers (La Fuente de los Amantes) and the Through (El Bebedero. Discover the distinct elements present in all Luis Barragán's later works, and how his command of elements such as texture, light and shadow effects and color so skillfully trigger emotions in the eye of the beholder.

LUIS BARRAGAN



Description: Guided by a licensed architect, follow in the footsteps of one of Mexico's most emblematic, but also most intensely - private architects: Luis Barragan.

Discover this illustrious precursor of Mexican modern architecture through a wide variety of his work in the city, and how light, color, texture, space and even his deep -rooted faith were common denominators in all of his works. A journey into the life and work of the only Mexican Pritzker Prize winner and a master who has left an indelible imprint on his nation's architecture.
